The scope of work can be broken down into economically feasible packages to facilitate DBE participation. Assistance in obtaining bonding, insurance and lines of credit is available upon request. DBE firms are referred to the Small Business Administration, U.S.DOT, Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization and/or the Federal Department of Transportation Bond Assistance Programs. In addition to the request for participation from DBEs, we request non-DBE subcontractors provide lower-tier DBE participation. Quotations must be valid for the same duration as specified by the Owner for contract awards. Subcontractors are required to possess and maintain a current contractor's license and be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations as required by Public Contract Code Section 1725.5. Subcontractors are required to execute Flatiron's Standard Subcontract Terms and Conditions, including the insurance requirements.
