16" WATER MAINS 2013 – CHATTAROY HILLS

Will be received by Whitworth Water District No. 2 at the District Office until 2:00 p.m., January 9, 2014 and at that time publicly opened and read aloud. One Contract is proposed for the entire work.

The proposed work includes:

This work is for construction of 16", 8", and 6" water mains for acquisition of the Chattaroy Hills Water system by Whitworth Water District No. 2. Included is approximately 2,000 l.f. of 16" ductile iron pipe, 12,000 l.f. of 16" PVC C-905 pipe, 7,670 l.f. of 8" PVC C-900 pipe, 1,070 l.f. of 6" PVC C-900 pipe. Also included is approximately 31 fire hydrants, 210 meter and meter box replacements, a pressure reducing vault station, a bore beneath railroad tracks, demolition of an existing elevated tank, and various other appurtenances including new services, valves, pavement and gravel repair, and general surface and landscape repairs.
