The City of Selah invites separate sealed BIDS for the construction of the 2013 DWSRF WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS, Federal Aid Project No. DM12-952-093, HLA Project No. 12129 including the following approximate major quantities of work:

Installation of approximately 5,700 LF of new 8-inch ductile iron water main including water services, hydrants, valves, connections to existing water mains, and other related improvements. Work includes surface restoration such as hot mix asphalt, cement concrete pavement, curb and gutter, gravel surfacing, and lawn repair.

This contract has ninety (90) working days to complete the work.

Bids will be received by the City Clerk at City Hall, 115 W. Naches Ave., Selah, WA 98942, until 11:00 A.M., February 12, 2014, and then shortly thereafter will be publicly opened and read aloud at the City Council Chambers located at 115 W. Naches Ave..

All bids or proposals must be in writing on the form bound in the Specifications, sealed and filed with the Clerk on or before the day and hour above mentioned.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project. All work performed on this project will be subject to the higher of the prevailing state or federal wage rates. The City of Selah is an Equal Opportunity and Affirmative Action Employer. The Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. Small, Minority- and Women-owned firms are encouraged to submit bids.

This project is a Federal-Aid funded project.
