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REQUEST FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING
STATEMENTS OF QUALIFICATIONS

The Purchasing Department of Clark Public Utilities, PO Box 8900, Vancouver, WA 98668 (USPS) or 8600 NE 117th Ave, Vancouver, WA 98662 (courier services), is soliciting Statements of Qualifications, up to the hour of **2:00 p.m. on Friday, January 31, 2014**, from professional engineering firms for the design, specifications, contract documents, cost estimates, reports and construction inspection services to construct Phase 1 Raw Water Transmission Main for the Paradise Point Water System. This solicitation shall henceforth be known as **Clark Public Utilities Phase I Raw Water Transmission Main for Paradise Point Water System, Request for Qualifications No. 331**.

Professional services requested include consulting engineering firms with expertise in Civil Engineering, Watermain Design Engineering, Trenchless Watermain Design Engineering, Geotechnical Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Archaeological Consulting, and Construction Inspection. The project scope is generally described as the engineering design and construction inspection of the Phase I Water Transmission Main for Paradise Point Water System. The Phase I limits are from Paradise Point Wellfield, under the East Fork of Lewis River and through the Paradise Point State Park, which is approximately 4,550 lineal feet.. The pipelines shall be a 24" raw transmission watermain, an 8" backwash transmission main, and a 2" communication conduit. The design and construction of the project must be complete by June 30, 2015. Firms who currently are registered and have uploaded a GSA SF254 form should replace this obsolete form with the new GSA SF330 form prior to the date and time responses are due. The RFQ No. 331 document specifically defines the scope of the project, as well as submittal requirements and selection criteria. Statements of Qualifications that do not follow the submittal requirements defined in RFQ No. 331 will not be evaluated.
