INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the Meadowmeer Water Service Association, c/o Browne Wheeler Engineers, Inc. located at 241 Ericksen Avenue, Bainbridge Island, WA, 98110, until 2:00 p.m., January 31, 2014, for the general contract for construction of approximately 2,700 linear feet of 6 inch ductile iron water main from the Meadowmeer Water Service association well site to their existing reservoir and construction of approximately 2,240 linear feet of 8 inch ductile iron water main along Koura Road to replace an existing 8 inch asbestos cement water main. The project also entails plumbing modifications at the reservoir and at the pump house. The time for completion on this project is 60 working days. Work on a portion of the project within a golf course must be completed within 40 calendar days of starting work in the golf course.

Availability of Bidding Documents: Contractors may obtain the contract documents at the office of Browne Wheeler Engineers, Inc. located at 241 Ericksen Avenue NE, Bainbridge Island, WA 98110; (206) 842-0605. Documents will be e-mailed upon request at no cost. Printed paper documents are also available, if requested 24 hours prior, for \$50.00 per set, or on a CD for \$10.

Bid Security: A certified or bank cashier's check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid amount, payable to the Meadowmeer Water Service Association, or bid bond executed by a licensed bonding company is required with each bid.

Rejection of Bids: The association shall have the right to reject any or all bids not accompanied by bid security or data required by the bidding document or a bid in any way incomplete or irregular. The Association shall also have the right to reject any or all bids and to waive all informalities in the bidding.

The Meadowmeer Water Service Association is an equal opportunity and affirmative action employer. Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (small, minority and women-owned businesses) are encouraged to submit bids. All work performed on the project will be subject to Davis-Bacon/Prevailing Wage requirements. All work performed on this project will be subject to the higher of the prevailing state or federal wage rates. Whistleblower protection must be afforded to employees of the contractor throughout the contract.

All bidders must have successfully completed projects funded by DWSRF, for which Davis/Bacon wages were paid. All bidders must be licensed contractors and bonded in the State of Washington.
