WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE \$4,350,000.00 BASE BID

Sealed Proposals will be received by the undersigned at the City of Mabton, 305 Main Street, Mabton, Washington 98935 (the US mail address is PO Box 655, Mabton, Washington 98935), up to 2:00 p.m.; local time on February 6, 2014, for furnishing the necessary labor, materials, equipment, tools, and guarantees thereof to construct Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvements.

Work shall consist of the construction of new headworks, aeration basin, secondary clarifier, effluent aeration manhole, electrical building, plant drain lift stations, non potable water system and sludge drying beds. Work shall also include modifications to existing operations building, oxidation ditch, sludge drying beds, secondary clarifier, effluent lift station and aerobic digester. Dewatering and excavation shoring may be a significant work activity for construction of new structures.

The Work shall be substantially complete within 360 working days after the commencement date stated in the Notice to Proceed. All bidding and construction is to be performed in compliance with the Contract Provisions and Contract Plans for this project and any addenda issued thereto that are on file at the office of the City of Mabton, City Hall, Washington.

The Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud shortly after the time and date stated above. Proposals are to be submitted only on the form provided with the Contract Provisions. All Proposals must be accompanied by a certified check, cashiers check, money order, or bid bond payable to the "City of Mabton" and in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount bid.

Contract Provisions and Contract Plans may be *examined* at the office of the City of Mabton, local plan centers in the project area, or the office of the Project Engineer, Gray & Osborne, Inc. Licensed Contractors and Material Suppliers may obtain a copy of the Contract Provisions and Contract Plans, free of charge, in electronic format (PDF on compact disk(s)) along with registration as a planholder *only* at the *Yakima* office of the Project Engineer, Gray & Osborne, Inc., 107 South Third Street, Yakima, WA 98901, (509) 453-4833. Request for Contract Provisions and Plans may be faxed ((509) 453-5953) or emailed (yakima@g-o.com). Request must include company name, physical address, phone and fax numbers, and email address. Registration as a planholder **is required** to obtain Contract Addenda. Contract questions shall be directed only to the office of the Project Engineer.

1. *A Prebid Conference is scheduled for January 22, 2014. The conference will begin at the City Hall, 305 Main Street, Mabton, Washington 98935 at 10:00 a.m. (local time). Prospective bidders are encouraged to participate. Any other site visits shall be limited to 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and shall be coordinated through Tanya Gaston, of the City of Mabton, by calling 509-894-4096, at least 24 hours in advance of the visit. No unauthorized visits or unscheduled visits will be allowed.*

2. *The City of Mabton is an equal opportunity and affirmative action employer. Small, minority-and woman-owned businesses are encouraged to submit bids. All work performed on the project will be subject to the higher of prevailing state or federal Davis-Bacon wage rates.*

Financing of the Project has been provided by City of Mabton, Washington and State of Washington Community Development Block Grant with federal funds from U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Department of Ecology, State Revolving Fund, Centennial Clean Water Fund and Public Works Trust Fund. The City of Mabton expressly reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals and to waive minor irregularities or informalities and to Award the Project to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder as it best serves the interests of the City of Mabton.
