



**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into a contract and furnish a satisfactory performance bond, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited. **Bonds submitted on other than the bond form provided by the department may be subject to rejection.**

For those contractors who are not prequalified, application for prequalification will be submitted on DOT Form 420-010 (Standard Questionnaire and Financial Statement) and must be received by the Prequalification Engineer no less than fifteen days prior to the scheduled bid opening to receive consideration for issuance of a bidding proposal for that bid opening.

Informational copies of plans and specifications are on file in the office of the County Engineer of the County in which the work is situated, the chapter offices of the Associated General Contractors of America in Spokane and the offices of the Regional Administrators or Headquarters of the Department of Transportation, where they may be inspected.
